

Robenacoxib: an effective pain-relieving medication for dogs and cats

When my cat was in pain, I saw her hiding away in the very corner and licking her wound. The pain renders us distance.

What's the best medication for your dog/cat to relieve pain?

If your dog/cat just had inflammation or surgery, robenacoxib is so far your best choice.

Robenacoxib is more effective and safer than the other anti-inflammatory drugs such as ibuprofen, naproxen, and aspirin. For postsurgical pain-relieving, robenacoxib is more effective than buprenorphine and meloxicam.

Even if your cat/dog has other health issues like osteoarthritis and/or chronic kidney disease, you can give robenacoxib to him/her for the long-term. The only side-effect in such cases is vomiting.

Even if your cat/dog has high blood pressure, it is safe to give him/her robenacoxib and the antihypertensive drug at the same time.

However, for now, we are only sure of the safety of the medication for dogs and cats.

Now, why is robenacoxib so effective and safe?

Different from other drugs, robenacoxib selectively interacts with the specific enzyme called cyclooxygenase-2 (COX-2) that causes inflammation and pain. It targets the inflammation sites persistently and therefore is more efficient than other drugs.
